

### Participated in Community Activities/Work Parties:

- 15 members trimmed the Tenoroc trails on August 24
- Worked with SWFWMD on the Hampton Tract's trail and parking issues; the parking lot has, after many years, been upgraded to a usable surface
- Had a strong turn-out for the annual Friends of Colt Creek public meeting (January)
- Organized and ran Colt Creek State Park's first Veterans Day Mounted Scavenger hunt November 9, which won the Florida State Parks "Outstanding Special Event" in the state.
