

You recently received a short **survey** about where/how and when to hold our meetings during the hot and buggy months of summer. We thank the 27 people who answered; the charts with all responses are at the end of the newsletter. Results:

- 11 people voted to find a restaurant in which to meet as their first choice
- 10 people voted for a teleconference
- 6 people prefer to stay at Colt Creek
- 5 people asked for a private venue

If we count first and second choices together the rankings remain the same.

As for the time of the meeting, 12 voted for Monday evening, 11 for Saturday afternoon, 4 for Tuesday evening, and 7 for Thursday evening.

Mike Woodard is planning a 2-day training and obstacle day. He'll let us know details as plans progress.








Del Jones has a saddle rack for sale for \$50. Call him if you're interested.
