

Triple B uses its funds for a variety of worthy causes, like donating to Hope Equine and the University of Florida Vet schools when it supported horses injured in the hurricanes. The club ride on April 29 will be at Sidney Dover Conservation Park. also called Dover Pits. It's located at 536 N. Dover Road, Dover, about .6 miles north of Hwy 60. PLEASE NOTE: there are multiple entrances, so be sure you use this one! It's got a very large parking



area. There is a \$2 entry fee, payable by credit card (not American Express) at a kiosk at the north end of the parking area. There is a water spigot and a porta-pottie.

There are new guidelines for equestrians on **concussions** and when it's safe to return to riding. While our instincts are to get right back up on the horse (to teach it that it can't get away with something, pride, failing to understand that we might have a head injury), it may not be the best thing for our long-term health. Less than 10% of people suffering a concussion actually black out. Failure to recognize a head injury and treat it accordingly can result in long-term brain injury.
