Event Coordinator Julie DeGeorge mentioned that school groups have offered to help with the horses; members felt that having people inexperienced with horses to lead was inadvisable from a safety standpoint; the club will decline that offer. Many of the riders this year were also well over 200 pounds and posed major challenges both to the horses and the people helping them to mount; a weight restriction of 190 to 200 maximum will be imposed for 2024.
