If you're interested in helping, please contact Janet Schneider.



Florida Sport Horse Club August 2022-July 2023 Year-End Report

Members are commended for their active participation and continual connection with each other during another challenging year. Weekend rides have been very well attended, and there have been an average of 2 to 3 pickup rides during the week.

The club began the year with 64 memberships and ended with 70.

Community Activities/Work Parties:

- Funded Eagle Scout Oliver Hund's proposal to place 10 new mounting blocks at Lower Green Swamp.
- The club sponsored Colt Creek's third **Veterans Day Scavenger hunt** on December 3, 2022, with 41 riders and 20 club members as workers.



13 club members showcased their love of horses to around 2,500 Polk County second-graders at Circle B Bar's "Water, Wings & and Wild Things."
