Sammie Turbeville gave us all some good advice on ground manners (horses, not humans!) at the November meeting.

- We must be the "leader of the pack" to our horses, keeping the horse out of our space.
- Don't let the horse push through gates or doors.
- Rather than popping the horse on the chest to move it back, tap the knees for a better result and learning experience.
- Trainers strongly advise against giving treats, as they can encourage the horse to nip or become aggressive.
- Teach your horse to yield. Use gestures, taps or physically move into its space—you should be able to move the horse forwards, back, or laterally.
- Pay attention to your horse's attitude and take its mood into consideration—horses can have bad days too, and training/riding may have to be modified for safety's sake.
- Teach your horse to stand, whether you're on the ground, mounting/dismounting, or in the saddle.

We appreciate all those members who not only stay in touch with each other but also let the officers know when somebody has been injured or has some sort of issue. We try to keep tabs on folks and let them know they are not forgotten! Please remember, though, that we are not mind readers—if you'd like the club to know about an injury, upcoming surgery, celebration or other life event, please reach out and alert our secretary, Janet Schneider.

The weekday pickup rides are still ongoing. They aren't always advertised, so if YOU want to ride during the week please email Janet, who can pass the message along to the club with your desired ride place, day and time.
