The only way in is through the main entrance, and the only parking is all the way at the back of the park in the equestrian camping area. The small road leading off the main drive is TERRIBLE and requires an extremely slow speed if you want your horse to keep his teeth from rattling right out of his mouth. We have complained to the park office. The **weekday pickup rides** are still ongoing. They aren't always advertised, so if YOU want to ride during the week please email Janet, who can pass the message along to the club with your desired ride place, day and time.
